Please review these rules before you start your exams



- Paper will be provided for all exams
- All necessary equipment must be brought to exams - pens, pencils, erasers, calculators, spare material etc.
- Sharing of equipment will not be allowed during exams.
- You must not leave your seat during the examination without the permission of the teacher.
- Talking or turning around will not be permitted.
 - If you are caught communicating or cheating, your behaviour will be recorded on your script and you will continue the exam to allow further investigation
 - A report of this incident will be sent to your muinteoir and realtoir
 - In case where immediate intervention is needed, Leas Príomhoide will be called
- If you require assistance raise your hand and wait in silence for the teacher to come to you.
- Examination Papers can only be handed up at the end of the exam. You must continue to work for the duration of the exam.
- At the end of the examination you must remain quietly in your seat until all exams have been collected.
- No exam papers or exam material can be removed from the room under any circumstance.
- Before the examination begins store any books in your bag
- Bags must be removed to the top of the room or outside.
- Exams will start strictly on time. Students that arrive late to exams may not be facilitated.
- A period of Staidéar may be organised for students before the examination. You must be prepared and bring all study material for that examination to that study period. However you will not be allowed to study until the designated exam time has finished.
- Students are permitted to use their desk in their examination centre as a study location at times when they do not have an exam, with the understanding that they remain considerate to those sitting an exam at that time.
- Good time keeping is essential and movement in and out of the examination centre will not be tolerated whether or not you are sitting an exam.

USE THE MOCK EXAMS AS A LEARNING EXPERIENCE

- Please remember that you have a nearly four months after the Mocks finish before the real exam and that courses are not completed.
- Do the best you can in every subject
- Make a few notes in the evening after an exam identifying improvements you can make particularly in exam technique (timing of questions, sections to focus on etc..)
- These arrangements should ensure that all students can gain maximum benefit from the examinations.
