# **Agreed Matters for Reporting to Parents**

### Principal's report:

- **Promotion and PR: Virtual Open evening:** To be held on 7<sup>th</sup> October thanks to Fergal Gallagher for his work on this.
- Student numbers: Currently 1003 enrolled. 220 places incoming 1<sup>st</sup> years.
- Anti-bullying: Post of wellbeing and anti-bullying coordinator was added by staff to list of school needs and priorities.
- School Plan: 6 priority areas were identified by staff in May 2021 for action in the next three years
