CAO

Students who wish to apply for third level colleges in Ireland must apply to CAO-Central Applications Office (www.CAO.ie). Early application to CAO by January 20th at 5pm for a discount fee of €30, otherwise application must be with CAO by February1st by 5pm. **Restricted entry** courses (courses that have an additional component e.g. audition, aptitude test etc.) must be on CAO application by February 1st.

CAO Change of Mind facility will be open from May 7_{th} to July 1_{st} at 5pm – the list on July 1_{st} is the student's final choice. **Restricted entry** courses cannot be introduced at Change of Mind stage!

It is very important that daltaí ensure they meet the entry requirements for the courses on their CAO application!

UCAS

Students who wish to apply to third level colleges in the UK & NI must apply to UCAS- University & College Admissions Service (www.UCAS.com) deadline 31st

	January . This is a lengthy process and daltaí must complete a personal statement, get a reference and predicted grades
PLC	Most PLC colleges are now open for application and this can be done directly through the college website
	Students who do a PLC apply through the CAO for a place in an Institute of Technology (IT) or University in 2025. Many of the CAO courses are linked to PLC courses. Students are strongly advised to check that the PLC course links to the IT or University course in which they are interested.
Apprentices hips	ITs and University have a number of places for QQI Level 5 applicants. Competition is high so hard work is necessary to achieve the highest grades possible. They are then competing with other QQI Level 5 CAO applicants and not with Leaving Cert applicants.

HEAR/DARE	We will be running HEAR/DARE clinics for daltaí after the Christmas break. This is to support daltaí applying, complete the educational impact statement and stamp necessary documents
