Dear Parents and Guardians,

In Coláiste na hInse, we pride ourselves on our school bród (pride), uaillmhian (ambition) and dearfacht (positivity). We would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge and thank the daltaí (students) and parents/guardians who continue to support and adhere to the school's Code of Discipline.

Following repeated supports, discussions, announcements, and communications around uniform, we have noticed a number of daltaí continually breaching the schools Code of Dress.

Our daltaí are representatives of CNI both in the school and in the wider community. There is a clear expectation that students wear the correct CNI uniform to and from school. **Please ensure that non-uniform jackets, leggings, t-shirts and shoes etc are NOT worn to school.**

If students are going on a school trip or representing the school in extracurricular activities perfect PE or full uniform must be worn. Failure to wear correct uniform may result in the dalta not being allowed to travel/take part in the activity.

If students continue to breach the Code of Dress, it will result in relevant follow up and sanctions.



Code of Dress

1. Full day school uniform must be worn each day except on PE day or on other approved occasions.
 - a. School skirt or trousers
 - b. White shirt
 - c. School jumper with crest
 - d. Black/navy leather shoes (runners are not permitted)
 - e. Navy socks/tights
 - f. School jacket
2. Full school PE uniform to be worn on PE day. Runners are permitted on these days only.
3. Good personal hygiene and presentation is expected each day.
4. For health and safety reasons looped or dangling nose or earrings are not permitted. One pair of stud earrings and one nose stud only are permitted.
5. Students are not permitted to wear makeup, nail varnish, false nails or visible tattoos.
6. The Coláiste na hInse uniform is striking and all partners are very proud of it. It is expected that uniforms will be well maintained and worn with bród (pride).
7. Students may be asked to wear the school tie and/or blazer on formal occasions while representing the Coláiste.
8. All uniform items should be clearly labelled with student's name. Coláiste na hInse cannot take responsibility for uniform items lost or stolen.
9. If a student attends school without full uniform their parents/guardians will be contacted, and appropriate measures adopted to address the issue.
10. Consistent breaches of code of dress will result in appropriate sanctions.
