What does child safeguarding mean?

It means what we do in school to keep children and young people safe from harm.

We think carefully about how to keep everyone safe and record this in our Child Safeguarding Statement and Risk Assessment. We review it every year and students are asked for their views.

If something worries you...

If someone says or does something that hurts you, worries you, or makes you feel uncomfortable, tell an adult you trust.
